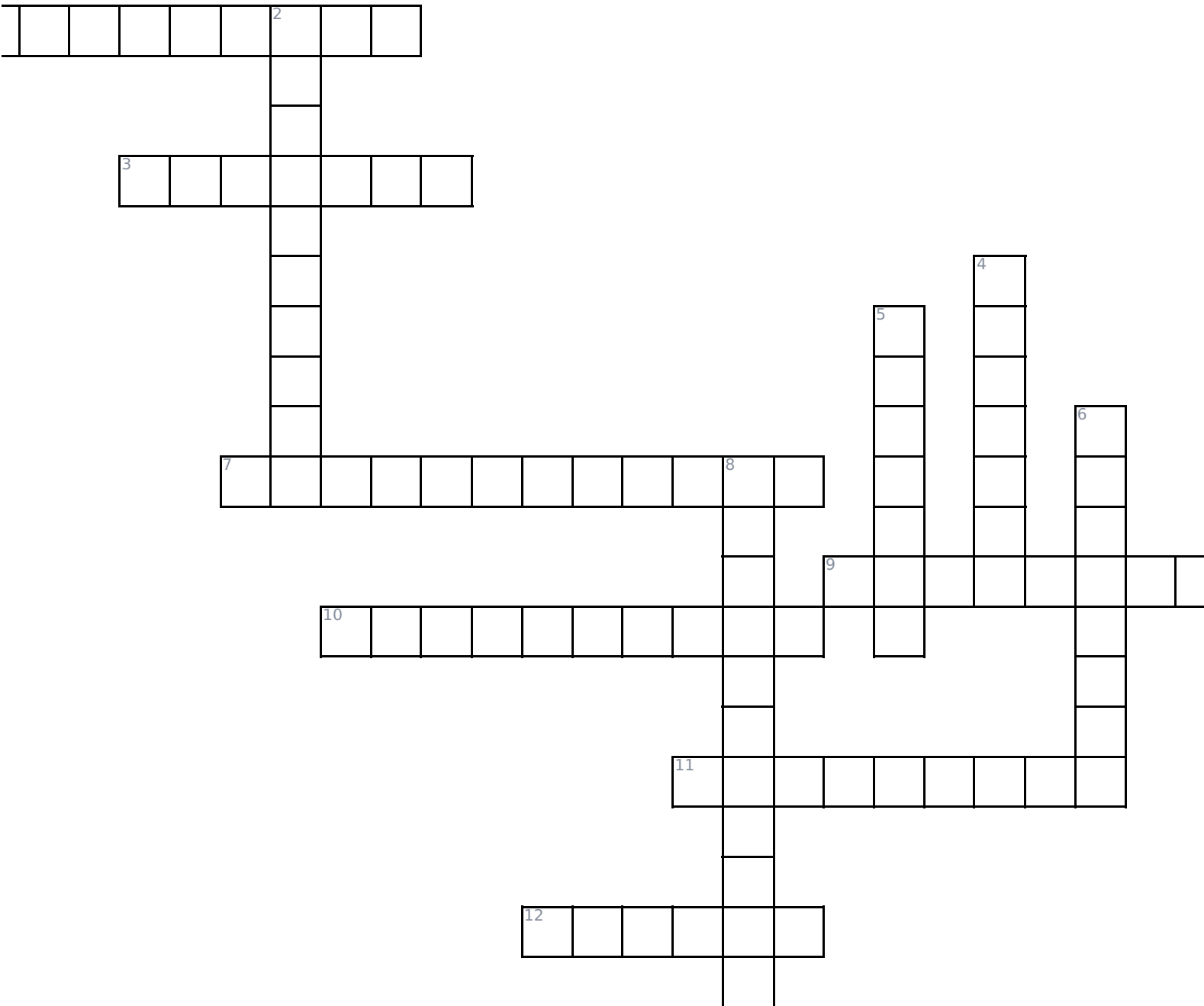


Contenders: Two Native Baseball Players, One World Series: Criss Cross
