- 4: 8-letter horizontal word starting at the first column, crossing the second and third columns.
- 5: 8-letter horizontal word starting at the second column, crossing the second and third columns.
- 6: 12-letter horizontal word starting at the eighth column, crossing the second and third columns.
- 7: 12-letter horizontal word starting at the third column, crossing the second and third columns.
- 8: 8-letter horizontal word starting at the first column, crossing the second and third columns.
- 9: 8-letter horizontal word starting at the first column, crossing the second and third columns.
- 10: 8-letter horizontal word starting at the sixth column, crossing the second and third columns.
