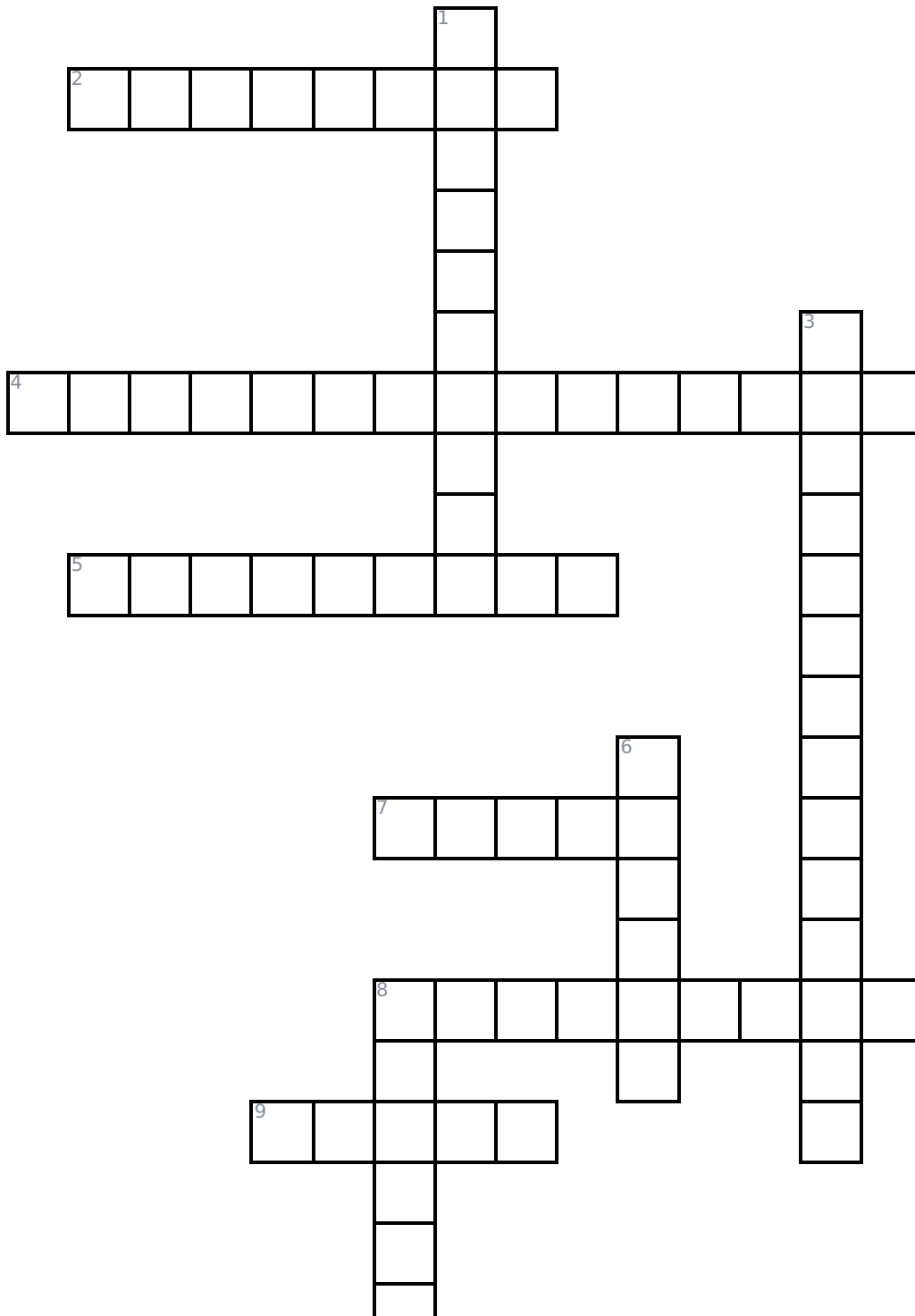


## Owen & Mzee: The True Story of a Remarkable Friendship: Criss Cross
