### **TIME TO READ!**

**Before reading, make predictions:** What do you
think the author means by
the title? Where might you
find this type of pool?

While reading, make connections: What area

where you live might be the home to this type of pool? Have you ever noticed small animals living in places that surprised you? Which animals in the book have you seen or heard before?

### After reading, extend your thinking:

- What surprised you most about some of the animals in the book?
- Explain the importance of the vernal pool.
- How does a vernal pool change throughout the seasons?



### **RELATED ACTIVITIES**

#### **SWIRLY SALAMANDERS**

Materials: newspaper, 9x13 pan, water, acrylic paint, dishwashing liquid, toothpicks, heavy paper

Lay out newspaper to protect working area. Fill pan with water. Add a couple drops of dishwashing liquid to water. Drop small amounts of paint onto the water surface. Use toothpicks to make swirls with the paint. When finished, lay paper on top of water surface to

"catch" the paint. Lift up and let dry. Do you think your swirls resemble the description of the salamanders in the book? Explain.



#### **POOL PARTY**

Materials: flashlights, binoculars or magnifying glasses

Invite some friends over for a vernal pool party. Gather your gear and set out on a search for vernal pools in your area. Remember, vernal pools are in low lying areas and occur in the spring. If you cannot find a vernal pool, look for other evidence of small animals in your area.
